Will Rogers

(1879-1935)

Will Rogers was part Indian and had a wide lopsided smile and the apparent simplicity of a cowboy from Oklahoma—all heart and folksy wit. Everybody loved Will Rogers. He was a rancher, humorist, and movie actor and he was greatly mourned when he got killed in a plane crash in Alaska. Claiming he never met a man he didn't like, Rogers came across as at once lovably naïve like Huck Finn and a shrewd man of the people. He spoke in rustic dialect and was mostly original, though he borrowed a few wisecracks from Mark Twain, twirling a lasso instead of puffing on a cigar. He was a grassroots humorist in the tradition of the South and West as opposed to the urbane humor of the East represented by the tradition of Oliver Wendell Holmes, Robert Benchley, S. J. Perelman and Dorothy Parker.
